Ecological Practice of School Social Workers

Kim, Hee-young (Professor at the Department of Child Welfare, NamSeoul University)

Currently, a paradigm shift regarding ecological welfare and environmental justice is taking place all over the world. School social work is also the time to accept this change in the social welfare paradigm and think about presenting and trying concrete action plans to realize ecological welfare in the school field. Above all, we should be able to actively accept the problem of the natural environment, which has been neglected so far, into the social work practice environment and face up to the reality of environmental justice and inequality occurring within it. The individual, group, and community skills and methods that school social workers already have and use will still be important tools for ecological welfare practice. It is hoped that school social workers' ecological welfare practice plans can change the school's ecosystem into a sustainable social work practice in schools.
